How to Vote

- Must be a Maine resident
- Vote for up to three (3) Maine nonprofit organizations from any of the regions listed, or select "other" and enter an eligible nonprofit organization(s)
- Vote online at www.bangor.com/cmm, or return this ballot by mail or in person to any Bangor Savings Bank branch
- One ballot or online entry per person

Eligibility Requirements for Write-In Nominations

- Registered as a 501(c)(3)
- Organization's program(s) is open to all (secular)
- Maine-based or with operating offices in Maine
- Ballots with votes for more than three (3) organizations are invalid
- The Bangor Savings Bank Foundation reserves the right to verify and/or reject ballots and nonprofit eligibility
- Public and/or private schools are not eligible

Community Matters More Time Period

- Voting begins January 23, 2012 and ends March 5, 2012
- All paper ballots must be received by mail or in person at any Bangor Savings Bank branch by end of business on March 5, 2012
- Grant winners will be announced in late March

About the Grants

A total of 68 grants will be awarded to the organizations listed on the ballot and to the top 20 write-in vote recipients (at least two write-ins per region). The top vote-getting organizations in each region (including write-ins) will receive \$5,000 each. The remaining 60 organizations will receive \$1,000 each.

Participation as a write-in candidate does not guarantee a grant, and organizations are eligible for one grant only.
